Grand Chapter History



The Most Excellent Grand Chapter of Holy Royal Arch Masons (PHA), Jurisdiction of North Carolina, composed of all of the constituent Holy Royal Arch Chapters in the jurisdiction, is recognized as the supreme authority in Holy Royal Arch Masonry in the jurisdiction by its members, and their pledge of allegiance and obedience hereto is acknowledged by their request for, and acceptance of, membership herein.

This Grand Chapter endeavors to maintain the ancient tradition, customs, and usages of Holy Royal Arch Masonry; to keep ever mindful of its principles; to assist the constituent chapters in solving problems that may confront them by making timely suggestions and promoting conferences, workshops, and various other forms of discussion for the betterment of Holy Royal Arch Masonry. And to secure uniformity of purpose and unanimity of action through conferences and convocations. This Grand Chapter was organized on June 25, 1946.

Most Excellent George P. Carnes was the first Grand High Priest, serving the Chair until 1948. He was succeeded by the following Most Excellent Companions in the order as listed:
